The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

This order be read in continuation of the order dated 11.08.2020. At the outset, Mr. Gautam Dutt, Addl. PP, Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Puran Singh, PS Sector 31, Chandigarh, submits that if a reference is made to para 2 of the petition, it has itself been stated that prior to filing of the present petition, the petitioner had never approached the police authorities.

In pursuance to the order dated 11.08.2020, the Warrant Officer had complied with the directions. In his report dated 17.08.2020, it has been *inter alia* stated that initially the residence of Manpreet Singh was not found and thereafter when it was asked from the Sarpanch of the village, it was told that he had shifted 10 years back from the village. The report further records that after satisfaction of the petitioner, the present report has been submitted.

In view of the above report, no further orders are called for.
