The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.429 dated 17.07.2020 registered under Sections 12 & 17 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and Section 506 IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 14.08.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the daughter of the complainant was having some affair with Gaurav. On two occasions, she was found in the company of Gaurav. The allegations against the petitioner

are that the daughter of the complainant was being compelled by the petitioner to have love affair with Gaurav and he acted like an agent. According to learned counsel, the statement of the daughter of the complainant, even if recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., will not go beyond the aforesaid allegation. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Surender Singh AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 17.8.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 5.10.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.08.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
