1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.38 dated 19.04.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 447, 511, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 30.09.2020, the petitioners joined investigation, fully cooperated with the Police, were released on ad interim pre arrest bail and their custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Gurbakshish Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 30.09.2020, the petitioners joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same, were released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and their custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 30.09.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
