By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.0038, dated 22.02.2020, registered at Police Station Lambi, Sri Muktsar Sahib, alleging therein the commission of the offences punishable under Sections 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 28.07.2020, the report of the learned SDJM, Malout, dated 18.11.2020, is on record, stating to the effect that statements of the complainant, i.e. respondent no.2 Namepal Singh, as also of the accused, i.e. the petitioners, were recorded before court to the effect that the matter has been compromised between them.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise is seen to have been arrived at between the parties amicably and voluntarily, without any undue influence, pressure or coercion; however, it has further been recorded

that there are 9 persons who were accused in the FIR but Vikas alias Money alias Mota, who did not appear to get recorded his statement (with him also not being a petitioner in this petition).

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant however submits that the complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed *qua* the said accused also, i.e. Vikas alias Money alias Mota.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0038, dated 22.02.2020, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
