The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 16.06.2019 under Section 377 IPC (Section 4 POCSO Act added later on), registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.

The earlier bail application was dismissed as withdrawn on 12.06.2020. Fresh one bail application has been filed on the ground of medical problem of petitioner. On the last date of hearing, a direction was issued to place on record the report of the Medical Board constituted by the CMO, Ludhiana. Today, the report has been placed on record, which reads as under:-

“Reference to Medical Report of UT Umesh 23/M.

I.D. Old Scar mark over midline of forehead MS 1 cm

In reference to letter no.9570 dated 10.09.2020 from Superintendent Jail a board of doctors comprising Dr. Baldeep, Dr. Varun & Dr. Aditya to examine him was constituted. Patient C/o Burning Micturition with pain

Epigastrium. U.S. Dated 25.08.2020 @ CH-Ldh shows grossly normal sonographic study. Patient was examined on 25.08.2020 was advised CBC, RFT & Urine R/E. Patient was re-examined on 15.09.2020 and advised CBC, RFT, RBS & Urine routine & provisional diagnosis of Urine Tract Infection (UTI) was made.

Regarding the queries asked by Jail Superintendent:

1. He is suffering from UTI and is afebrile.
2. Patient is hemodynamically stable and complaint of pain epigastrium with radiation to back.
3. He doesn't require admission at CH, Ludhiana and can be managed in Jail Hospital. However, he is advised follow up with investigation advised on 15.09.2020 and 18.09.2020 in OPD.”

Accordingly, necessary medical care be given to the petitioner in the jail hospital or even outside, if so required in custody.

In view of the same, no ground to release the petitioner on bail is made out. However, he may move this Court in case of any serious complication or development.

Dismissed accordingly.
