Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners wanted to solemnize marriage but the private respondents, who are parents of petitioner No.2, were adverse to their relationship and marriage. Hence, now petitioner No.2 has moved in with petitioner No.1 and is in a live-in relationship with him since the first week of August. On a query put to the learned counsel, he categorically denied the registration of any criminal case against petitioner No.1 or any DDR having been recorded qua the missing of petitioner No.2.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation dated 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if

any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
