The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.74 dated 01.06.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 188, 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC and Sections 3, 33, 89 of SC & ST Act at Police Station Rozka Meo, District Nuh.

Learned State counsel states that Mohit had filed the complaint in respect of occurrence in question. Learned State counsel has also endorsed the affidavit filed by Mohit. Complaint dated 29.05.2020 was filed by Mohit against the complainant party. Mohit also belongs to schedule caste category.

In view of aforesaid, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer/SHO on 31.08.2020 at 11 AM and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
