1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-1) dated 01.07.2020 to respondent Nos.2 & 3 but that no action has been taken in respect thereto till date and that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same, in a time bound manner.
