The petitioner has filed this civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus so as to direct the respondents to decide the representation/ legal notice dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide legal notice dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P-8), the petitioner has made a request to the respondents for releasing his pensionary benefits while counting his entire *ad hoc* service.
