GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Ritu Rani and Deeparsh, stated to be aged 27 & 22 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) was submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities

concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-4) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2) as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
