By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 for not harassing her and her husband Yogesh Kumar Garg at the instance of respondents No. 4 to 10 on account of solemnization of marriage by her and Yogesh Kumar Garg against the wishes of private respondents No. 4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner and her husband Yogesh Kumar Garg is not acceptable to the private respondents No. 4 to 10 and they are harassing them. Annexure P-3 is the marriage certificate issued to the petitioner and her husband. Annexure P-4 is the postal receipt that her representation for protection has been received by respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.
