The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.131, dated 12th July, 2019, registered under Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

2. On going through the order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CRM-M No.13796 of 2020 – 'Rajbir Singh vs. State of Haryana'** on 19th June, 2020, it is verified that the said co-accused was not directly granted Anticipatory Bail on account of the fact that he was a Proclaimed Offender. On the other hand, he had been directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court and seek Regular Bail after observing that this was a fit case to grant him Anticipatory Bail, which however could not be given considering his status as a Proclaimed Offender.

3. The present Petitioner also stands on the same footing to that of co-accused-Rajbir Singh.

4. In the circumstances, the Petitioner, who is an old lady, is likewise directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a week from today after which an appropriate order on her Application for Bail, if so filed, shall be passed by the Ld. Trial Court expeditiously.
