AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court apprehending danger to his life and liberty as well as his family members from the private respondents in the present petition. Assertion has been made that there are cross cases, which have been registered and the petitioner has suffered a gun shot injury. The private respondents are still threatening the petitioner. Highlighting these aspects, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-8) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required, within a period of fifteen days.
