Grievance of the petitioner is that his family was assaulted by police officials posted in Police Station, Manimajra, during the curfew/lockdown due to COVID-19 situation. His complaint, in this regard, is still pending with the higher officials, however, his family is being threatened by the police officials. He is seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against respondent Nos.5 to 7.

As per letter dated 28.09.2020 sent by the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh, during enquiry, statements of respondent Nos.5 to 7 have been recorded. It was found that petitioner-Dilawar Khan himself visited the Police Station to get free his brother. The allegations levelled against the police officials are insubstantial and have no connection with

the brother of petitioner not to violate the rules in view of COVID-19 situation, but he (brother of petitioner) along with his associates was outside his house without any specific reason. When the police officials directed him to adhere the rules, he along with the petitioner, started misbehaving with the police officials.

A perusal of the above letter shows that nothing has been found against the respondent police officials. In view of the said fact, no further directions are required to be given in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
