The petitioners are the residents of village Akabarpur Nataul, Tehsil Hathin, District Palwal who have prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents to constitute a Gram Panchayat for their village as envisaged under Section 7 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and on the basis of the recommendations made by respondent no.4 on 12.09.2014.

Before approaching this Court, the petitioners have made a representation to the Deputy Commissioner, Palwal, which was received in his office on 28.04.2020.

The grievance of the petitioners is that the said representation dated 28.04.2020 has not even been considered by the Deputy Commissioner till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4 and submits that the representation dated 28.04.2020 made by the petitioners shall be decided in accordance with law.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued by this Court to the respondents for deciding the representation dated 28.04.2020 in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.1 to 4 to consider the representation dated 28.04.2020 (Annexure P-5) and decide the same as early as possible but preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
