The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.112 dated 08.04.2020, under Sections 148, 188, 269, 270, 307, 354, 323, 332, 353, 506 and 149 of the IPC read with Section 51/57 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Section 3 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897, registered at Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 08.04.2020. Thereafter, investigation against him has since been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. In such circumstances and without commenting upon the other merits of the case, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and
