The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.223 dated 10.07.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

On 18.08.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner stood as surety for her son Hakumat Sharma (accused) to get the vehicle released on superdari. According to him, the terms and conditions were violated by

Hakumat Sharma and, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner in the present case may not be necessary.

Notice of motion for 27.11.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shavinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer and she is no more required in further investigation of the case.

Petitioner stood as surety for her son for releasing the vehicle on superdari. Terms and conditions of superdari were violated by the son of the petitioner.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, therefore, custodial interrogation is not required as she has cooperated with the investigation.

In view of above, order dated 18.08.2020 is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
