GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Sunita Devi, stated to be aged 24 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of her life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Goyal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based on the pleadings, submits that petitioner got married with respondent No.4 on 06.06.2014 and from that wedlock, a daughter and a son were born. He further submits that the due to harassment and misbehaviour of respondent No.4, petitioner left her

husband's house on 08.08.2020. Learned counsel then submits that for the same/similar grievance, petitioner had filed a representation dated 08.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioner approaches the police authorities concerned with representation (Annexure P-2) with regard to her alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by the Superintendent of Police, Grain Market, Govindpura, Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana (respondent No.2) and decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four months from today, in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Grain Market, Govindpura, Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
