In the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 to 11 on account of their marriage which has taken place on 12.08.2020. The marriage certificate has been appended as Annexures P-5.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 21.09.1994 as per Adhar Card (Annexures P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 04.04.1999 as per Adhar Card (Annexure P-2).

A representation dated 12.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) has also been filed with respondent no. 2 in this regard, in which it has been stated that it is an inter caste marriage.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
