Report of the Additional District Judge, Jalandhar has been received.

As per the report, out of 11 prosecution witnesses, 09 PWs have been examined and examination-in-chief of remaining 02 PWs has been done. Both these witnesses were present in the Court on 07.10.2020 for their cross-examination and conclusion of the prosecution evidence, however, counsel for the accused – Chief Obonna, pleaded no instructions on his behalf and thereafter, the trial Court provided a legal aid counsel to him and the case is now fixed for 19.10.2020 for cross-examination of the remaining 02 witnesses.

Considering the fact that there is a delay on the part of the accused itself, I find that the extension of time of 03 months granted to the trial Court needs further extension.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of another 03 months time from today.
