The case has been taken up for hearing through
video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section
439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 153 dated 17.03.2020,
registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Farakpur,
District Yamuna Nagar.

The allegations are that three boys came on a
motorcycle and snatched an amount of Rs. 4500/- in cash and a
mobile phone from the complainant. The petitioner was arrested
on 20.04.2020 on the basis of secret information. On the basis
of his disclosure statement, an amount of Rs. 500/- has been

recovered along with the motorcycle. The challan has already been presented. Co-accused Shivansh was granted bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri on the basis of his juvenility vide order dated 19.06.2020. Co-accused Jatin has also been granted bail by the High Court in CRM-M-20376 of 2020 vide order dated 10.08.2020. The involvement of the petitioner on the basis of secret information and alleged recovery of motorcycle without any mark of identification would remain debatable.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ban Singh SI, submits that the challan has already been presented and charges have not been framed so far. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the aforesaid position, without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the situation arising out of COVID-19 pandemic, I am of the view that petitioner can be enlarged on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
