The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 162 dated 25.02.2020 registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat under Sections 203, 180, 384, 389, 120-B IPC and Section 7, 8 & 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Sections 328, 376-D, 506 IPC deleted).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the role of the petitioner is identical to the role of co-accused-Saroj Devi who has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 06.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-16153-2020 (Annexure P-4). Thus, the petitioner may also be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel is unable to dispute the aforementioned submission.

Keeping in view the principle of parity, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
