By this petition, the petitioner is seeking issuance of necessary directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to look into the representation dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) and ensure that the petitioner is not harassed or humiliated by respondents No. 3 and 4 at the instance of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a civil suit dated 9.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) with respect to agreement to sell is pending in the trial Court. A complaint was made by the private respondent No. 5 against the petitioner that he has forcibly entered the house and stolen the articles. These allegations proved to be false as per inquiry (Annexure P-2).

The grievance of the petitioner is that he is being harassed again by the private respondent No. 5. A representation dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) has been made by the petitioner to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of this case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
