All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ directing respondents no.1 to 3 to safeguard their lives and liberty at the hands of respondent no.4.

Pursuant to the order dated 09.09.2020, a very detailed affidavit has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, District SAS Nagar, eventually stating that the husband of the petitioner/former husband, i.e. respondent no.4, was also found to have married another woman living now at Sunder Nagar (Himachal Pradesh), from whom he also has a daughter.

It has further been stated that the area of the house of the petitioners is being regularly patrolled and that respondent no.4 is no longer found to be harassing the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that they are no longer being harassed by the respondent no.4.

That being so, while appreciating the work done by the District Police, Mohali, (though after orders were passed by this court), the petition is disposed of, with the direction that the lives and liberty of the petitioners shall continue to remain protected (as is the duty of the police) and any reports of respondent no.4, or anybody at his instance, harassing the petitioners, would be taken seriously and acted upon by the police.
