Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.108 dated 28.10.2019 registered under Sections 341, 324, 379, 148, 149 IPC 1860 (Section 307 IPC was added) at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

On 20.08.2020, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

*“Counsel for the petitioner has relied on the compromise dated 02.04.2020, Annexure P4, executed between the injured and the accused. He has also placed reliance on the order dated 19.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-54445-2019-Malkit Singh @ Malkiat Singh Vs. State of Punjab. He submits that interim bail has been granted to another co-accused in CRM-M-23334-2020-Simranjit Singh @ Simarjit Singh Vs. State of Punjab, vide order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench in the earlier part of the*

*day.*

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab assisted with Mr. G. S. Bajwa, Advocate for the complainant, who are available on conference call accepts notice,. Copy of the petition has already been supplied to them. Counsel for the complainant submits that there is no dispute regarding the factum of the compromise between the parties.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-23334-2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 20.08.2020 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surjeet Khan submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
