Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.108 dated 28.10.2019 registered under Sections 341, 324, 379, 148, 149 IPC 1860 (Section 307 of IPC was added and Section 324 IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

On 20.08.2020, this Court passed the following order:-

“Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 108 dated 28.10.2019 registered under Sections 341, 324, 379, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC was added and Section 324 IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur..

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and no specific role or injury has been attributed to him in the FIR. He further submits that a compromise dated 02.04.2020 (Annexure P-4) has been effected between the parties and co-accused, namely, Malkit Singh @ Malkiat Singh and Dalip Singh @ Deepa, have already been granted bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. H.S. Sitta, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and points out that though no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner, yet in the statement of injured-Sandeep Singh, recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., injury No. 1 on his person, declared dangerous to life, has been attributed to the petitioner.

Adjourned to 28.10.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 20.08.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Surjeet Khan submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.08.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
