By way of this application filed under Section 24 CPC, the petitioner-wife seeks transfer of Case No. HMA-1094-2020 filed by the respondent-husband under Section 10 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short, 'the Act), from the file of the learned Judge, Principal Family Court, Ludhiana, to the file of the learned Additional District Judge, Family Camp Court, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

By order dated 19.08.2020, this Court directed notice to be served upon the respondent-husband and stayed further proceedings in the subject case.

Today, Mr. Jasjit Singh Rattu, learned counsel, entered appearance for the respondent-husband and filed his power of attorney. Learned counsel states that his client was desirous of withdrawing the petition filed by him under Section 10 of the Act for judicial separation but owing to the stay order passed by this Court in the present case, the Family

Court, Ludhiana, did not permit him to do so. Learned counsel would further state that his client is no longer desirous of pursuing the case filed by him before the Ludhiana Court. The statement made by the learned counsel is duly taken on record.

In the light of the aforestated stand of the respondent-husband, this application for transfer of the pending case from the Ludhiana Court to the Mukerian Court no longer survive for consideration.

In that view of the matter, the transfer application is dismissed as infructuous. Interim order dated 19.08.2020 shall stand vacated.
