1. This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ, order or direction for quashing the impugned auction notification dated Nil (Annexure P-9) vide which e-auction of residential and commercial properties in Gurugram and other cities was directed and prays for allotment of a plot under oustee quota.
2. Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 states that the petitioner has been found eligible for a six marla plot and now the name of the petitioner will be put in draw of lots which is likely to be conducted shortly.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this view of the matter, the petition may be rendered infructuous.
4. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

5. Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending, C.M (s), if any, also stands disposed of.
