The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of leave encashment of Rs.9,13,000/- and for payment of GIS amounting to Rs.89,435/- with upto date interest @ 12% per annum on delayed payment. Petitioner has further sought a direction to the respondents to re-fix his pay.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to examine his legal notice dated 03.06.2020 (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dheeraj Jain, Advocate, who is available on conference call, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon him.

Without going into the question of entitlement of the petitioner and without considering the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner in the present writ or in the legal notice, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Central Reserve Police Force-respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 03.06.2020 (Annexure P7) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
