The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for entrustment of FIR No.56 dated 19.04.2017 under Sections 304-B and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural) to the Central Bureau of Investigation and further to issue directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to complete the investigation in the case.

Learned State counsel has filed fresh status report by way of affidavit of Jogeshwar Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division, Majitha, Amritsar Rural on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in Court, which is taken on record.
