After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Civil Court for the redressal of the grievance of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has raised an apprehension that keeping in view the pandemic of Covid-19, the petition, which he intends to file after withdrawing the present proceedings, might not be listed as only urgent cases are being listed and though, the present litigation is also urgent, he might face some difficulty in getting the petition listed.

The apprehension of the petitioner is not well founded. Once the petitioner will be praying for an interim order in the suit to be filed by the petitioner, same will surely be considered as an urgent matter to be heard by the Civil Court at the earliest.
