The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Vipin Kumar alias Guddu, stated to be aged 22 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0188 dated 16.10.2019, registered under Sections 379-B & 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Records of the case show that on 25.08.2020, notice of motion in this case was issued.

On instructions from the police official, Learned State counsel submits that there are three more FIRs against the petitioner. He further submits that the challan has been presented, however, charges are yet to be

framed. The next date before the trial Court is fixed for 17.10.2020 for framing of charges.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition after framing of charges.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
