The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 226, dated 27.08.2018, under Sections 363, 376, 343, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.
