ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners have challenged the order dated 25.06.2020 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Additional Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Union Territory, Chandigarh and resolution dated 27.06.2020 (Annexure P-9) whereby the petitioners have been removed as office bearers of the society. Learned counsel contends that the petitioners were duly elected office bearers of the A.W.H. Cooperative and Maintenance Society Ltd. and they could not have been ousted before the expiry of their term.

Issue notice to the respondents No.1 and 2.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Akshay Jain, Advocate for U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 and contends that the petitioners have already availed alternate remedy by challenging the impugned orders through a revision petition before respondent No.1.

At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that although revision was preferred on 10.06.2020 but no action has been taken

thereon and respondent No.1 may be directed to decide the same expeditiously especially the stay application which is to come up for hearing on 08.09.2020.

Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioners are availing the alternate remedy and have filed the revision petition. In such circumstances, I do not find any good justification to entertain the instant writ petition while exercising the jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Respondent No.1 is, however, directed to decide the revision preferred by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of.
