The grievance of the petitioner is that she is being harassed by respondent No. 3 at the instance of respondents No. 4 and 5 who have made frivolous and false complaint against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has lodged FIR No. 44 of 2020 registered under Sections 302, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar, against her husband. She is staying in matrimonial house and she is being harassed by respondent No. 3 at the behest of respondents No. 4 and 5. He further contends that civil suit bearing No. 1357 of 2020 is pending in the Court of Sudhir Kumar, PCS, Civil Judge (Junior Division) and vide order dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) status quo has been ordered in favour of the petitioner.

The petitioner has made a representation dated 25.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural in this regard.
