Present petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order of the transfer, which has been effected by the respondents vide order dated 10.08.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that the petitioner has been retained in Gurgaon but has been transferred to another Branch. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has been allowed to pursue his bachelor of law degree by the Corporation Bank prior to the merger of the same with the Union Bank and apart from other difficulting being faced by him, the said transfer of the petitioner is coming in his way for attending the classes of bachelor of law. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for this purpose, the petitioner has sent an e-mail to respondent No.2, which has been appended with the petition as Annexure P-4 dated 11.08.2020 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to pass appropriate order on the said request, extended to respondent No.2 by the said e-mail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Goel, Advocate, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioner dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) within a period of one month from the receipt of copy of this order.
