The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No. 365 dated 04.06.2020 on the file of Police Station City Rohtak, District Rohtak, registered under Sections 306, 201, 34 IPC. By way of this petition, she seeks regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner has been in custody since 04.06.2020. The other co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted bail. According to the prosecution, the petitioner and the deceased were in a live-in relationship and he either committed suicide or was killed owing to the dispute that he had with her. Admittedly, investigation in this case has not resulted in the addition of any further offences and as matters stand, the

Charge against the petitioner is one of abetting the suicide of the deceased.

The police has already completed the investigation in the matter and filed the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Given the present situation caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic, there is no possibility of the trial being completed expeditiously. That being so, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would be entitled to grant of regular bail subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail upon her furnishing a personal bond for a sum of ₹20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person connected with the case. She shall also deposit her original passport with the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.
