Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate decision on the show cause notice dated 19.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and for further taking appropriate decision on renewal of the arms licence of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that aforesaid show cause notice was issued to the petitioner on account of registration of an FIR under Section 420 IPC with the allegations that he has used a forged certificate, while contesting the elections of Sarpanch. It is further submitted that arms licence of the petitioner expired on 14.09.2017 and till date, no decision has been taken and the petitioner urgently need renewal of the same, as he is facing threats to his life. It is also submitted that the petitioner has submitted the reply to the show cause notice before the District Magistrate way back on 12.07.2018,

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however, the same has not been considered and is still pending with the District Magistrate.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ashok Kumar Sehrawat, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 & 3, Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra and District Magistrate, Kurukshetra respectively, to decide the case of the petitioner in pursuance to the show cause notice as well as for renewal of his arms licence.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of and District Magistrate, Kurukshetra-respondent No.3 is directed to take a decision in pursuance to the show cause notice as well as on the request of the petitioner for renewal of his arms licence, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to him, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
