The present contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 19.12.2019, vide which, a direction was issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 13.05.2019 by passing a speaking order.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the order has been complied with and the representation has since been decided and the relief has been granted to the petitioner.

In view of the same, nothing survives in the present contempt.

Dismissed accordingly.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the entire amount has not been given and the details of the interest has not been provided to the petitioner as to how the same has been calculated. If it is so, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh representation, if not already filed and

in case the same is filed within two weeks, the respondent shall decide the same as well and pass speaking order on the fresh representation qua the deficiency of the interest, if any.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
