1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel contends that the grievance of the petitioner is of his being pressurized by respondent No.3 to compromise the matter with respondent No.4, despite the petitioner having been inflicted grievous injuries by respondent No.4 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner submitted a representation (Annexure P-2) dated 05.08.2020 to respondent Nos.2 & 3 for fair and impartial investigation in the matter but that no action has been taken on the same, till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law.
3. Notice to respondent No.2 only.
4. Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Copy of the paper book has already been supplied to him. Learned DAG states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the controversy, the petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-2) dated 05.08.2020, and take such action in the matter in accordance with law, as may be warranted, in the facts and circumstances of the case.
