Petitioner has prayed for issuance of directions to the respondents to take serious cognizance of the complaint dated 2.3.2020 filed by him before respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has complied with the requirement of Section 154 Cr.P.C. even in the form of moving representation before respondent No.3 in terms of Section 154 (3) Cr.P.C., but no action has been taken. Thereafter, petitioner got issued legal notice to respondents No.2 to 4 on 17.7.2020, but no action has been taken so far.
