The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.191 dated 12.10.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar Samana (wrongly mentioned Police Station, Samana in the FIR), under Section 306 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 01 year and there is no other criminal case pending against him. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as even, charges have not yet been framed. Thus, the petitioner may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 29.10.2020 has been produced in Court and the same is taken on record. According to said certificate, the petitioner has undergone custody of 01 year and 13 days and there is no other case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that the charges have not yet been framed.

Thus, it is evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and there is no other case pending against the petitioner. Under the circumstances, the interest of justice requires that the petitioner be

released on regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner
