This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.194 dated 15.03.2020 under Section 379-A Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 04.09.2020, whereby the interim protection was extended to the petitioner.
