The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking anticipatory.

On 9.9.2020, the following order was passed:

"In response to order dated 19.08.2020, Status Report by way of affidavit dated 26.08.2020 of Sh. Gurvinder Pal Singh, DSP, Banga, District SBS Nagar has been filed in the Registry of this Court, the same is taken on record. Registry to tag the Status Report at the appropriate place.

Perusal of para 6 of the aforesaid affidavit reveals that in view of the MLR dated 21.06.2020, petitioner-Baljeet Singh suffered the following injuries:-

- 1. Incised wound approx. 2.5 x 0.5 skin deep present over the occipital region. Dried blood present. Advise X-raySkull.*
- 2. Complain of pain and tenderness at left wrist joint.Movements are painful. Advise X-ray left wrist.*

Still further, another injured-Manpreet Singh from the petitioner's side also suffered following injuries:-

1. *Incised wound approx. 9 cm. x 1 cm. underlying muscle and bone cut present over left fronto parietal region. Dried blood present over there. Advise surgery opinion.*

2. *Incised wound approx. 7 cm. x 1.5 cm. (at its maximum) underlying muscle of bone cut present over left side of forehead, present horizontally. Dried blood present over wound. Advise Surgery opinion.*

3. *Lacerated wound over right side parietal region at 3 cm. X 1 cm.*

Learned State Counsel seeks time to have instructions in the matter regarding status of investigation.

On his request, adjourned to **07.12.2020**.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C."

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Duni Chand submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and no custodial interrogation is required and recovery has been effected.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted on 9.9.2020 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
