Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.2, dated 01.01.2020, registered under Section 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 1400 tablets Tredol containing Tramadol salt and 800 tablets Prozolam containing salt Alprazolam. As per the order passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, the recovery from the petitioner falls in commercial category as notified by the Central Government under NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner has fairly stated that the petitioner is a previous convict. He has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 10 years, against which the appeal the pending.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact and without commenting on

the merits of the case, this court does not find good ground to grant bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Hence, dismissed.
