Application is allowed. The sealed result of the petitioners is taken on record.

CWP No.12184 of 2020

This is a petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned action of respondents not to allow the petitioners to appear in the departmental examination for the post of Accountant going to be held on 21.08.2020 without any justifiable reason while allowing other similarly placed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the result produced by the respondents before this Court, the petitioners No.1 and 2 have qualified the exam whereas petitioner No.3 has not qualified for the same. Therefore, the petitioners would be satisfied if the said

result of the petitioners is taken into consideration by the department for declaring the petitioners No.1 and 2 as qualified.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Mr. R.K. Singla, Assistant District Attorney, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, is also not averse to taking into consideration the above-said result of the petitioners for the purpose of declaration of petitioners No.1 and 2 as qualified for the said exam.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take into consideration the marks obtained by petitioners No.1 and 2 in the above-said present examination and then to determine the fact whether the petitioners No.1 and 2 have qualified the said exam or not.

Since the original result of the petitioners was placed on record of the present case along with a CM, therefore, it is further ordered that original result of the petitioners be returned to the learned State Counsel on her furnishing the certified copy of the same. After that, the certified copy of the said result shall be kept on record of the case.
