Case taken up through video conferencing.

This is a petition for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.155 dated 12.8.2019 for the offence under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala, for three weeks i.e. from 21.8.2020 to 9.9.2020 to attend the marriage ceremony of her daughter.

In the petition, it has been contended that the petitioner is behind bars since 12.8.2019 on the allegations that when apprehended by the police party on 12.8.2019, she was found in possession of 450 gms. of heroin. Of course the recovered contraband amounts to commercial quantity. She had filed a petition for regular bail before this Court, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 7.7.2020. Now she has approached this Court for grant of interim bail for the reason that marriage of her daughter

is fixed for 22/23.8.2020. However, we are past those dates since today is 25.8.2020. Furthermore, in the verification by Gram Panchayat village Rajgarh (Annexure P4), it is mentioned that Anjali is an adopted daughter of Manjit Kaur and in that way, she is not natural born daughter of petitioner.

It being so, the petition has become infructuous and is dismissed accordingly.
