The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 05.11.2019 passed in CR No. 4713 of 2019.

It is not disputed that in pursuance to the last order of this Court dated 05.11.2020, the key has been handed over to the petitioner.

In view of the same, nothing survives in the present contempt petition, the same is dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the rent for the period for which the shop was in possession of the respondent has not been paid. This fact is however disputed by learned counsel for the respondent on the ground that the litigation was with his father and the order was also against his father, who died on 05.02.2020 and therefore, the

respondent is not bound by any compromise, if at all. Accordingly, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail remedy, as available to him in law, if so aggrieved.
