The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 03.07.2020, registered under Sections 304-B, 149 IPC at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The operative part of the order dated 21.08.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is a married sister-in-law of the deceased. The marriage of the petitioner was solemnized in 2008 whereas the marriage of the deceased with the brother of the petitioner was solemnized on 29.03.2020. Further, totally false & frivolous allegations have been leveled against her by the complainant.

It has been further contended that similarly situated co-accused Monika has been extended the concession of

interim bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 13.08.2020....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 21.08.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State assisted by counsel for the complainant and on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.08.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
