The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 57 dated 13.03.2018, registered under Sections 307/323/506/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The operative part of the order dated 21.08.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the present petition has been necessitated as the police is delaying the presentation of the challan. An offence under Section 307 IPC is not made out against the petitioner as she was allegedly holding bricks and stones only.

Notice of motion for 23.11.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 21.08.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.08.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
